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Training on enterprises promotion of MMP

To develop the income sources of Most Marginal people we have organized 10 no of trainings on enterprises promotion for MMP at operational area of our organization with XIM officials. 35 no of women have trained and developed their income

sources through those trainings. We have given financial support to MMP to develop their income sources.



Interface with legal counseling Committee

We have formed legal counseling committee at block level to take up steps to solve the problems arising by atrocities inflicted to the women instead of going to courts. We try to solve the problems amicably. We have solved **12** no of such cases during the year 2011-12._



Workshop with Apex body

If we fail to solve the problems arising by atrocities it is referred to Apex Body at the district level. District level Apex Body Helps the victims to solve the problems at judicial level.



Skill Development Training

Training programs are taken up in collaboration with resources persons from various trades like spices and condiments, Appliqué, mushroom, vermin compost and Bamboo works etc. They impart trainings how to develop their skill to get optimum benefits from the trade they adopt. We have arranged 15 no of training camps and 450 beneficiaries have trained by such camps in the year 2011-12.



Interface with Bank

We also cooperate the SHG groups to sort out their problems to obtain loans from different banks. The banking officials are also invited to have a discussion with the beneficiaries to address their problems and we help them to sort out their problems in the banking level by the help of bank officers.

Business Management Training for the MMPs

To develop the financial growth of the SHG we have arranged 5 no of training sessions at Block level 250 beneficiaries were trained in those training programs. The resources person from different trades trained them regarding the marketing of their products. Its main aim is to sell their products like Appliqué, Spices, Bamboo works at different markets and marketing agencies.



Distribution of Relief to Flood Affected People

12 thousand people were affected with super flood which occurred during this year. With the great support of local political leader and donor we have distributed clothes, Horlicks, Biscuits, and Noodles to flood affected people of Rajas, Sumana, Pampalo and Nariso GPs.



Mega Health Camp at Flood affected area

To provide better health check up to the flood affected villagers our organization has arranged 5 no of mega health camps in the marooned area of Rajas, Sumana, Pampalo and Nariso GPs of Khurda District. With the medicinal and doctor support of Catholic Charities, Jatani we have arranged mega health camp at Barahala, Rajas, Darada, Srirampur and Alisisasan. 1500 peoples were treated at those camps.



Sanitation Program

To keep clean and diseases free environment and create awareness among the village dwellers we have organized **5** no of sanitation programs in different places of Balipatana Block with the support of Govt. officials and other NGOs during the year 2011-12. **200** SHG members have already attended the sanitation program. We also arranged a cleanness rally at Rajas GP of Balipatana Block. **500** no of village level volunteers and school students have attended this rally.



TB Awareness Meeting

With the support of Orissa Volunteer Health Association we have arranged a TB awareness meeting at Kedarpalli Slum of Bhubaneswar Municipal Area. The **100** SHG members of **10** SHG of different slums have attended the seminar. The officials of RNTCP have shared their valuable tips regarding the easy treatment of TB. A quiz competition has conducted among the SHG members regarding TB.



TB Awareness Training

With the support of Akshya India Global TB Project Odisha we have arranged one day training program regarding TB. Dr Bijayalaxmi Dash, Dr Subrat Ray & Subash Das were the resource persons who have attended the capacity building training on TB. **30** no of participants from **15** no of NGOs have taken training at our Head Office.



Plantation of Medicinal Plants

To keep view on diseases free earth our Organization has been planting medicinal plants since few years. With the support of School Students, local political leaders and our volunteers we have planted **250** no of medicinal plants in different schools, road sides and waste lands of our locality. We also arranged **5** no of awareness generation mass rally programs regarding plantation of medicinal plants in different GPs of Balipatana & Baliana Block of Khurda District.



Awards for Best Students

On every year our organization has been celebrating the Death Anniversary of our former president Sri Baikunthanath Mishra. In this day we have distributed some prizes to the best students of Balipatna & Baliana block of Khurda district. In this year we have arranged such program and gave awards to the best students who have kept maximum marks in the HSC examination. A block level debate competition was also being conducted. The best speakers were awarded with prizes and certificates.



Health Activities under NRHM Project

OPD service

Since all the slums under the optional areas have no easy access to reach at the Govt. Hospitals and Dispensaries, GJS started the OPD centre to provide immediate health services and free medicines to the slum inhabitants. As per the norms, one part time Doctor, one Pharmacist and one ANM are engaged and rendering the OPD services. The OPD opens at 8.00 am to 12.00 pm & 4.00 pm to 6.00 pm at each working day except Sundays & National holidays. 7822 no of patients have been attended through the year. The details are as follow.

Referral Services

As envisaged in the fore going paragraph, complicated cases like accidental cases, diarrhea, malaria, TB, institutional delivery, sterilization cases etc are being referred to the nearest Govt. hospitals and dispensaries. During the period, 1738 (Male-544, Female-1194) cases are referred.



Outreach Health Camp

The OPD under this program has been set up at a place which is convenient to the slum dwellers of the nearby areas to provide primary health care facilities. Outreach health camps have been conducted on each Saturdays (fixed under the guideline) with advance intimation and motivation in the particular slums by the Link Volunteers. Similar facilities like general health check up and free medicines are being provided in the OPD. These camps are being managed by the Doctor, Laboratory Technician, Pharmacist, ANM and Link Volunteers provided under the scheme. 1139 no of patients have got benefited on 33 no of outreach health camps during the year 2011-12



Urban Immunization in collaboration with Govt.

The Link Volunteers and ANMs are propagating and motivating the people to attend the immunization sessions being conducted by Govt. on designated days to provide immunization like Polio, DPT, Missiles, TT, BCG etc and providing all assistance to the slum children as well as pregnant women to reach the immunization centers and get them fully immunized. Link Volunteers are reaching at the door steps to immunize the drop out and left out cases for immunization. The Govt. ANM gives the vaccines to the patients/children. During the reporting period 86 no of immunization sessions have been attended by our Link Volunteers and ANM.



IEC/BCC

IEC/BCC is most important way for community mobilization. Various printed leaflets, posters, handouts are distributed in the slum areas to educate the slum dwellers on safe motherhood, immunization, malaria, TB, water sanitation and to develop cleanness habits. Instead of distribution of leaflets trainings, sensitizations and meetings have been conducted by the project staff to create awareness among the slum dwellers. All the 60 no of slums are covered through IEC/BCC program.



Antenatal Care

ANC within 12 weeks, 13-28 weeks and 29-38 weeks are registered by the concerned Link Volunteers and ANM. The staffs are attending in the ANC on regular intervals. The complicated and high risk cases are being referred to the nearest Govt. hospitals and dispensaries. Iron folic tablets are being distributed on free to those pregnant women. They are also being motivated to attend immunization sessions organized by Govt. project at different times. They are also being given tips for safe institutional delivery and management of risk during the pregnancy period. During the year 2011-12 the following no of registration on different cases have been achieved. _____

1. 0-12 weeks-**33**
2. 13-28 weeks-**105**
3. 29-38 weeks-**73**



Postnatal Care

As follow up action after delivery, the project provided services through the Link Volunteers and ANM to visit the beneficiaries at door step to teach them about timely care, breast feeding, adopting different immunizations for the new born babies and complementary feeding for newborns and infants. They are following 42 days supervision to such mothers. 182 no of postnatal care cases were handled by us during 2011-12.



Institutional Delivery

For safe and smooth delivery, the Link Volunteers and ANMs are propagating the utilities of Institutional Delivery instead of unsafe home delivery. For the program we are providing free conveyance to the beneficiaries for their movement to the nearby Govt. hospitals and dispensaries. During the reporting period 132 cases of institutional delivery conducted.

CBD Training

To adopt temporary family planning methods CBD training program was conducted among the SHG groups, eligible couples and house wives at regular intervals. The Link Volunteers and ANMs are going round the slums to provide contraceptives devices (Oral pills and Condoms) through a depot, and motivate the community. 16 no of CBD trainings have been conducted and 257 members trained in such training.



Adolescent Training

Persons in the age group of 10-19 years are referred to as Adolescent. There are changes of bodily, mental and emotional during adolescence. In case of girls the age between 8-13 years time of transition is happened. This is a time when an adolescent's body begins to undergo change. Adolescent is a time of expanding relationships. Due to parental pressure some adolescents get married early. They have low awareness and knowledge regarding sexual and reproductive health. Under pressure of parents and in-laws they are bearing children early. GJS conducted 24 no of adolescent training camps and 413 adolescents were trained in that camps. ANM teaches them how to keep personal hygiene in the time of menstruation, unsafe sexual practices, unsafe abortion risk of exposure to Reproductive Tract Infections and sexual transmitted diseases and HIV/AIDS, and also make aware them to wear clean clothes.



Family Planning

The small family norm has been largely accepted and internalized by the people of Odisha. Slum populations have limited access to family planning services. The aim of family planning is to reduce total fertility rate. The permanent family planning is needed for that. In the project area, awareness has been created among the slum people to take permanent family planning methods like tubectomy and vasectomy as well as temporary methods like contraceptives (oral pills and condoms). During the period , 3 no of family planning camps organized and 31 permanent family planning (tubectomy) done. Although 1 failure case is detected in our operational area and the rest 30 have been sterilized properly.



Nutrition Health Education Day

In every month nutrition and health education day have been observing at Anganwadi Center to make aware the lactating mothers. In this day the Govt. ANMs aware the lactating mothers regarding breast feeding, complementary feeding and supplementary feeding. The supplementary food is also being provided to the postnatal women and children by the anganwadi centre. The ANM and link Volunteer supported the Anganwadi Workers and Govt. ANMs in that particular day. They keep the weight of new born babies as well as the mothers. They also help in distribution of supplementary nutrition to the beneficiaries. 22 no of such programs have been attended by the project staff.



Impregnation of Bed net

The misquotes are one of the most causes of Malaria. To control the malaria in slum the Govt. provides free medicines for impregnation of community owned bed net. The survey of bed nets have been conducted by the Link Volunteers in all 60 slums. We have already covered all the slums for impregnation of bed net. Impregnation of 3511 no bed nets have already been completed by the Link Volunteers. The community awareness done on use of the use of bed nets.



SDC Meeting

To keep coordination among all the communities, Slum Development Committee meetings conducted in different slums of the operational areas. In this connection we have already conducted 3 no of SDC Meetings with the participation of Corporators, ASHAs, AWWs, School Teachers and Govt. ANMs etc. Necessary awareness was done on role and responsibility of front line leaders for the betterment of the community. All the problems and their solutions in the communities have been discussed in the meetings.



Monthly Review cum Planning Meeting (Staff)

Each month, a review cum planning meeting has been conducting with the internal staff of Gopinath Juba Sangha at Urban Health Center. The Chief Functionary of the organization was participated and reviewed programs already done in the field and office level. During the meeting, the achievement/activities conducted during previous month and plan of action for the next month discussed in front of the staff members.



STI/RTI Services

As per the community based STI/RTI prevalence study (2003), over 6% of the adult population in India suffers from one or the other STI/RTI episode annually. There is enough evidence to suggest that early diagnosis, treatment and management of STI/RTI including inducing behavior change through education amongst the target groups. The presence of HIV affects the clinical presentation, course, diagnosis as well as management of STI/RTI. However the prevalence of the STI/RTI is high in the urban slums. Keeping in the views, necessary awareness programs are conducted in the slums by the staff. **10** no of STI/RTI cases identified and referred for necessary treatment.



Pulse Polio

To make Polio free world the Pulse Polio program was conducted every year. Our organization has been attending Pulse Polio camp at different villages of Rajas GP. In this Year we have attended **12** such camps by our volunteers. **500** children of different areas were immunized in those camps.



Aids Awareness Program

AIDS is the one of the dangerous diseases in this century. The main cause of the dieses is unsafe sexual relationship. To create awareness among the youths we have organized **5** no of Aids awareness camps at different areas of Balipatana Block. In this context we have trained **200** above youths of our locality regarding

Activities Under Health of the Urban Poor Project

We are implementing the Health of the Urban Poor(HUP) program in Bhubaneswar Municipal corporation, Bhubaneswar in the following slum like 46,47,52,53,54,56,57,58,59 from 1st March 2012 with the financial support from Population Foundation of India, New Delhi and USAID –INDIA. The detail activities are given below:

Survey and Research

Before the implementation of the program we have completed survey, Mapping, Listing and slum profile work in our allotted slum in prescribed format given by HUP-PFI. Before survey HUP provide training to all field staff for smooth survey.



Capacity Building Training for HUP Field Staff

HUP-PFI provides training to HUP field staff for strengthening and skill up-gradation and smooth implementation of the program. HUP provides training to staff like Maternal Health, New born care and child health, water sanitation and hygiene, Family planning and mother child tracking information for counseling to the target beneficiary at door step.



Observation of Designated Days

We have observed the world water day at Kapileswar Bhatta Bhoi sahi and Kapileswar Bhoi sahi on 26th -27th March 2012. In this occasion we have organized street play and community art on water sanitation & hygiene. The main aims of the program is to

aware the slum people to dispose their house hold garbage in dustbin without thronging outside.



World Population Fortnight

We have organized World population fortnight at Kedarpalli Basti under ward No-47 jointly by our Urban Slum Health program. In this occasion we have arranged event like quiz competition among Mahila Arogya Samit (MAS) on Maternal Health and Healthy baby show among 0-1 year children. With the grate support of Corporater ward No-47, BMC, CMMO Bhubaneswar municipality Hospital, Medical officer Urban Health centre, GJS, City Coordinator & NGO-CBO Coordinator, HUP-PFI the meeting had finished successfully. The main focus of the program is to aware the mother and community to adopt birth spacing method, small family norm and stabilize the population growth rate.



Observation of Brest Feeding Week

We have observed World Breast Feeding week at Kargil basti under ward No-30. In this occasion we have organized events like quiz competition among mother those who have children upto 0-1 year. In that process we have arranged a meeting at Kargilbasti with the resource person Dr. Anjali Sinha, Medical Officer of USHP, GJS. The main aims of the program is to generate awareness among the mother and community about exclusive

breast feeding up to 6 months and breast feeding continue up to 2 years with complimentary feeding.



Film Show

We are organizing Film show program in 4 no of slums like Tati basti, Kargil Basti, Kedarpalli and Jogeswarpatana Behera Sahi. In this program we are sowing a film 1.45 hours on maternal health. The main focus of the program is to aware about Maternal health, Antenatal care ,Post natal Care, Birth preparedness and birth Micro planning.



Mahila Arogya Samity (MAS)

Community mobilization is a process through which community individuals or groups plan, carry out and evaluate activities on a participatory and sustained basis to improve the health care and other needs. Major purpose of community mobilization include demand generation, ensuring optimal utilization of services, establishing referral linkages, increasing community ownership and sustainability and establishing a community based monitoring system. In this context HUP constituting MAS group in

every slum.MAS will act as focal community group in each area implementation of the HUP program interventions, specifically the MAS will facilitate the HUP program to fulfill the goals.



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
